Dear Parent/Carer,

I am pleased to offer your child the chance to go 10-pin bowling, summer shopping or both (Cambridge) on Monday 23rd July. Students who decide to go 10-pin bowling will need to pay for it when they arrive at the leisure park.

This trip is our way of celebrating the good behaviour, positive attitude and successful completion of their work experience placement. Students who are eligible will be offered the opportunity to attend. In conjunction with our behaviour policy, the students eligible **MUST** have a positive points score for their conduct on the behaviour system – the students who have a negative points score will not be eligible and will be provided with alternative activities at school.
