Dr. Kueh is a very experienced school leader, with a wealth of school improvement knowledge and expertise. Prior to joining us, Dr. Kueh was a Deputy Director of Ofsted. The school will continue to have the support of our Director of Education Paul Lawrence. As CEO, I will take a keen interest in Melbourn and be a regular presence in the school.

We want our parents to have the opportunity to talk to us and hear about the school improvement process. Our partnership with parents is important to us. We will be in touch shortly about a parent engagement event. This will be a chance for us to share our continued improvement plans for the school and for us to also hear from you.

I want to reassure you that we are working hard to ensure stability for the whole school community, and I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support.
