We are pleased to share the outcome of our recent Ofsted inspection, which marks a significant milestone in Melbourn Village College's journey of improvement.

Following the inspection in May 2025, Ofsted has confirmed that MVC is no longer rated "Inadequate". We are especially proud that our Behaviour and Attitudes have been judged "Good", reflecting the respectful, calm, and positive environment that staff and pupils have worked hard to create.

Inspectors noted that:

"Pupils are proud of their school and are delighted by the improvements that have been made."

"They feel settled because staff share clear and consistent expectations for behaviour and learning."

"Pupils behave well. They know what is expected of them and respond positively to the way staff apply the school rules."

"Many pupils achieve well. This is because they often benefit from learning in a well-planned and well-taught curriculum."


"The trust and school leadership have made rapid improvements. These actions are making a clear difference to pupils' experiences."
